The Power of Prayer

Some of the famous prayers of the great souls as described in Srimad Bhagavatam

Prayers of Queen Kunti:

vipadaḥ santu tāḥ śaśvat tatra tatra jagad-guro bhavato darśanaṁ yat syād apunar bhava-darśanam

"I wish that all those calamities would happen again and again so that we could see You again and again, for seeing You means that we will no longer see repeated births and deaths." (SB 1.8.25)

Prayers of Bhismadeva:

śita-viśikha-hato viśīrṇa-daṁśaḥ kṣataja-paripluta ātatāyino me prasabham abhisasāra mad-vadhārthaṁ sa bhavatu me bhagavān gatir mukundaḥ

"May He, Lord Śrī Kṛṣṇa, the Personality of Godhead, who awards salvation, be my ultimate destination. On the battlefield He charged me, as if angry because of the wounds dealt by my sharp arrows. His shield was scattered, and His body was smeared with blood due to the wounds." (SB 1.9.38)

Prayers of Prahalad Maharaj:

yadi dāsyasi me kāmān varāms tvam varadarşabha kāmānām hṛdy asamroham bhavatas tu vrne varam

"O my Lord, best of the givers of benediction, if You at all want to bestow a desirable benediction upon me, then I pray from Your Lordship that within the core of my heart there be no material desires" (SB 7.10.7)

Prayers of Gajendra:

jijīviṣe nāham ihāmuyā kim antar bahiś cāvṛtayebha-yonyā

icchāmi kālena na yasya viplavas tasyātma-lokāvaraņasya mokṣam

"I do not wish to live anymore after I am released from the attack of the crocodile. What is the use of an elephant's body covered externally and internally by ignorance? I simply desire eternal liberation from the covering of ignorance. That covering is not destroyed by the influence of time." (SB 8.3.25)

Prayers of Lord Brahma:

tat te 'nukampām su-samīkṣamāṇo bhuñjāna evātma-kṛtam vipākam hṛd-vāg-vapurbhir vidadhan namas te jīveta yo mukti-pade sa dāya-bhāk

"My dear Lord, one who earnestly waits for You to bestow Your causeless mercy upon him, all the while patiently suffering the reactions of his past misdeeds and offering You respectful obeisances with his heart, words and body, is surely eligible for liberation, for it has become his rightful claim." (SB 10.14.8)

Prayers of the Gopis:

tava kathāmṛtam tapta-jīvanam kavibhir īḍitam kalmaṣāpaham śravaṇa-maṅgalam śrīmad ātatam bhuvi gṛṇanti ye bhūri-dā janāḥ

"The nectar of Your words and the descriptions of Your activities are the life and soul of those suffering in this material world. These narrations, transmitted by learned sages, eradicate one's sinful reactions and bestow good fortune upon whoever hears them. These narrations are broadcast all over the world and are filled with spiritual power. Certainly those who spread the message of Godhead are most munificent." (SB 10.31.9)

Sri Isopanishad:

agne naya supathā rāye asmān viśvāni deva vayunāni vidvān yuyodhy asmaj juhurāṇam eno bhūyiṣṭhāṁ te nama-uktiṁ vidhema

"O my Lord, as powerful as fire, O omnipotent one, now I offer You all obeisances, falling on the ground at Your feet. O my Lord, please lead me on the right path to reach You, and since You know all that I have done in the past, please free me from the reactions to my past sins so that there will be no hindrance to my progress." (Iso Mantra 18)
